#### RESULTS FOR QUARTER ENDED 31 MARCH 2013

As at today's date Eurogold has a share portfolio valued at \$10.275 million and cash reserves of \$205,000.

Taking into account the debt to Allied Group, the Company has an unaudited current NAV of \$0.1090 per share.

During the quarter the company reduced its administration costs by \$79,000, a saving of 42% from the previous quarter, through reductions in salaries, directors' fees and as a result of moving to smaller premises.

In February 2013 the Company entered into a Variation of Loan Agreement with AP Finance Limited to vary the existing facility amount to HK\$8,200,000 (A\$1,023,196) and extend the term of the loan for a further 12 months. A renewal fee of A\$50,000 was paid to AP Finance Limited on 18 February 2013 in consideration of the Lender agreeing to the Variation. Outstanding interest for the 12 months was paid in full in February 2013. No further funds have been drawn down on the loan.
